- · Tidal power plants Is clean and needs very little maintenance
- Neither creates smoke/emissions nor noises
 When electricity is generated on site, waste is minimized
- · Less waste equals lower electricity costs.

- · "Coldnessbusses" in winter to give homeless people a warm place to stay

Die Tafel - Deutschland e.V.

- · Greatest social and economical project in Germany
- Founded 1993 in Berlin
- · Collects food that cannot be sold anymore and gives it to needy people
- Today: more than 690 "Tafeln"
- 60.000 volunteers save 265.000t of food every year
- · Other countries copied the idea





Ringo – Waste management

- Developed open platform to reuse packages Built northern Europe's largest food packaging cleaning center
- Provides collection, washing and deposit handling of registered packages

 • 100 thousand disposable packaging items will
- not directly end up in a garbage can









Innovation and Infrastructure

Innovations from Germany:

- Transrapid → a train powered by magnetic rails
 "Autobahn" → first Freeway in 1924 in Berlin
 Siri → based on Al developed in Germany

- Airbag → by Mercedes Benz (Stuttgart)
 Computer → "first" computer by Konrad Zuse, 1941

- "G-Digital" to support digitalize companies
 96- Tickets for whole Germany to make traveling available
 "Bürgergeld" (welfare benefits paid by the state) to support people who are not able to work
- BMW started producing and exporting hydrogen cars

- Integration/language course for children and
- teenagers with an immigrant status DaZ lessons must be offered at every school
- · No grades are given, only evaluations Integration of students whose native language is not German depending on the individual level of
- language development Attending a gradually increasing number of regular lessons (e.g. P.E., mathematics, English, etc.)

GENDER EQUALITY

- The Parliamentary Prayer Group succeeded in amending a law that would have made a modicum of sex education mandatory in Romania's
- Proposed by the Save Romania Union (USR), the one genuinely progressive party in Romania's parliament
- · Romania's ranking in gender inequality has dropped from the 18th to the 21st place since 2018.
- · The country is furthest away from gender equality in economic decision-making, ranking 26th.
- · Since 2010, Romania's score has decreased in the domain of work and power. Consequently, Romania's ranking has dropped in these domains from the 18th to the 22nd and 21st places, respectively.





Farmer Cooperation Solawi

- In the Solawi Cooperation you pay a monthly fee, and you get a weekly box with ecological and seasonal foods
- · You can select your foodbox, depending whether you like eggs, meat or bread
- . If you don't want something you can put it in the exchange box form which other people can take it for free
- · Everything is produced sustainably
- The subscription system gives safety to the farmers
